CUCKOO'S **NEST**

The Radisson Blu Riverside Hotel is located within the Lindholmen Science Park Gothenburg, a Swedish innovation hub. In designing the hotel's restaurant and bar, Stylt Trampoli AB sought to create a lively diversion from the glass-and-steel buildings that dominate the development. "We took our inspiration from the area's long history of industry and technological innovation," says Erik Nissen Johansen, the firm's creative director and founder. "Scientific discoveries often happen on the edge between madness and genius, and that borderland also seemed like a great location for a bar and restaurant." The result of Stylt Trampoli's efforts is Cuckoo's Nest, an inviting, quirky space that's part old-fashioned library, part laid-back history museum and part science lab. •
